



Last call for One World Award Nominations

The One World Personality Award – also known as “VIP” Award (Very Impacting Person) – was bestowed “post mortem” to the Nobel Peace Prize Winner Prof. Wangari Maathai in a very emotional and inspiring ceremony at the United Nations Environmental Programme in Nairobi on November 15th. With this award the impressive and outstanding achievements as a tireless campaigner and activist for environmental conservation, democracy, human and especially women rights, peace and justice were honoured. The partners of the One World Award – the pioneering German organic company Rapunzel Naturkost and the International Federation of Organic Agriculture Movements (IFOAM) presented the certificate and the beautiful “Lady OWA” statue to Wangari Maathai’s daughter Wanjira.

The award steering committee is now looking forward to the OWA 2012. Nominations have already been coming in from all over the world, yet there is still the chance to nominate. To give potential nominators a chance to use the hopefully quieter days over the holiday season and towards the end of the year the (definite) deadline has been extended to December 31st.

“Every OWA finalist is a source of energy for countless people around the globe who believe in a better, an organic planet. Sharing success is an enjoyable and effective way to change the world,” says Markus Arbenz, Executive Director of IFOAM, encouraging people around the world not to miss to nominate the ones that deserve it. Out of the





nominations the steering committee will select the five finalists in the first week of January.
